Sarah Jones's Will

In the Name of God Amen, I Sarah Jones of the County of Halifax & State of North Carolina, being weak in body, but of perfect sound Mind & Memory, do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament in Manner following. To wit, I give bequest and devise to my loving son Albert Jones & to his heirs & assigns forever, three Negroes Namely Jacob, James, & Jack. I also give to loving Daughter Sylvia Perry & to her heirs & assigns forever one Negro Wench Aggy. I also give to my Grand Daughter Winney Nichols & to her heirs forever, one feather bed & furniture, & all the Household Goods that are left my Death. It is my desire that the said Cott my son Brittain shall have them, & I do hereby nominate, constitute & appoint my son Brittain Jones Executor to this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 27th day of September 1792
