give to my Daughter Elizabeth one Shilling, Item I give to my Son James one Shilling, Item I give
to my Son John one Shilling, Item I give & devise to my Son William and to his heirs the land whereon I
now live containing one hundred and more or less. Item I give & bequeath to my Daughters Sarah & Martha
the residue & remainder of my Estate of whatever kind or nature I ever to be Equally divided between them
& their heirs I do constitute and appoint my Son William Story & Robert Carter joint Executors of this
my last will & Testament, it is my will & desire that my wearing apparel be divided equally between
my three Daughters Elizabeth Sarah & Martha, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& seal this 16th day of May 1790
