her heirs & assigns for ever the following Negroes Bob. & Mose and
Apply for them But if my Daughter. Sokeyann should not
Apply in person it is my Desire that my son Samuel Goodwin
should Take Charge of the said Negroes Bob & Mose and Remain in
Quiet possession of them for ever.

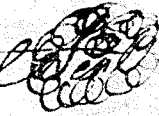
Item. I give and promise to my son Geddon Goodwin One Negro by the

I now live with all the plantation Tools and Creatures that I don't give in
Legacy to my children and With Every other article of my Estate of what kind
soever to her my S^r wife during her life and then the S^r articles of Estate is
to be divided of all the S^r plantation Tools to be used together by my wife
