

In the Name of God Amen. I Theophilus Joyner of the County of Halifax State of North Carolina being sick in Body, but of sound Mind and Memory & recollecting the frailty of this Transitory State of Existence do therefore make & ordain in this my last will & Testament as follows vizt.

Impairing I surrender my soul into the hands of that adorable omnipotent, Being from whom it originally proceeded & my mortal Body to be committed to its Creator I Just Men, Mind to my beloved wife Sarah Joyner the plantation & Land whereon I now live called Richmond, & during the full term of her natural life times & for during the same term of time, I also lend to my said wife Sarah Joyner all my negroes & the my just debt & paid, all my stock of Horses Cattle Sheeps and Hogs also all my Furniture & every other article of my moveable property of every kind: But at the decease of my said wife Sarah Joyner my will & desire is that in case a certain Polly Barnes the reputed Daughter of my said wife Sarah Joyner be then alive she the said Polly Barnes Daughter of my said wife Sarah, shall have & enjoy all & singular the above listed property of every kind to her the said Polly Barnes then alive & her heirs forever. Provided nevertheless that in case of the decease of the said Polly Barnes before she becomes of age or intermarries my will & desire is that my wife Sarah Joyner shall thereupon the property & enjoy as her own the simple Estate not only all & singular the above listed property but also all the rest of my estate, both said stock, house hold furniture & what it shall or may be hoped of at the time of my decease to her my said wife Sarah Joyner & her heirs forever. I do give & bequeath to the above mentioned Polly Barnes (the aforesaid Daughter of my said wife Sarah Joyner) my plantation & Land called the old place where I formerly lived which was patented by David Bunn & contains as per a late survey two hundred & fifty four Acres half more to her the said Polly Barnes & her heirs forever. Lastly I constitute and appoint my wife Sarah Joyner executrix & my Brother Budgeman Joyner & my Friend David Sane Executor to her my last

Richmond, do during the full term of her natural life time & for during the same term of
time, I also lend to my said wife Sarah Joyner all my negroes & the my just debts are paid,
all my stock of Horses Cattle Sheeps and Hogs also all my furniture & every other article of m-
moveable property of every kind: But at the decease of my said wife Sarah Joyner my will
desire is that in case a certain Polly Barnes the reputed Daughter of my said wife Sarah
Joyner be then alive she the said Polly Barnes Daughter of my said wife Sarah, shall
& enjoy all & singular the above lent property of every kind to her the said Polly Barnes
then alive & her heirs forever. Provided nevertheless that in case of the decease of the said Polly
before she becomes of age or intermarries my will & desire is that my wife Sarah Joyner shall
thereupon possess & enjoy as her own the simple Estate not only all & singular the above lent
property but also all the rest of my Estate both Land Stock house hold furniture & what so ever
may be possessed of at the time of my decease to her my said wife Sarah Joyner & her heirs forever
I do give & bequeath to the above mentioned Polly Barnes (the above said Daughter of my said
wife Sarah Joyner) my plantation & Land called the old place where I formerly lived which was
patented by David Bunn & contains as per a late survey two hundred & fifty four & an half acres to her
the said Polly Barnes & her heirs forever. Lastly I constitute and appoint my wife Sarah Joyner
executrix & my Brother Budgeman Joyner & my Friend James Lane Executor to this my last
will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 29th
day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety one
