make intercession for me through the merits of our Lord
and Saviour Jesus Christ Amen

I Give and Bequeath unto my wife Anne
Bull all my estate during her life time and widow
hood. Item I Give unto my two daughters Anne and
Sarah the Plantation which I now live to be Equally
divided between them to them and their heirs forever
and to the heirs lawfully begotten of their body, only
one is to have the Plantation whereon I now live
after my Wifes decease Item I Give and Bequeath unto
my children after my Wifes decease all my Estate Lands
other Chattels &c only what is above mentioned unto my sono
Thomas Bull Henry Bull Alexander Bull and Ann
Bull and to them and their heirs forever to be Equally
divided among of them

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my son in law Jessie
Bull five Shillings Virginia Money to be paid out of
my Estate to him and his heirs forever.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my daughter Anne
and her heirs forever Item I do desire that my
Apprentice advertisement sale on my plantation
may be given out that the same may be sold

Sommes now come to make my final will and testament to
make distribution for me through the merits of our Lord
and Saviour Jesus Christ forever —

I Give and Bequeath unto my wife Susannah
Bull all my estate during her life time and widow
hood. Item I Give unto my two daughters
and Ann the Plantation where I now live to be equally
divided between them, to them and their heirs for ever
and to the heirs lawfully begotten of their body, only
one is to have the Plantation where I now live
after my Wifes death, Item I Give and bequeath unto
my children after my Wifes decease all my Estate Lands
Stock Chattels & rufel what is above mentioned unto my sono
Thomas Bull Henry Bull and small Bull and Ann
Bull and between and their heirs forever to be equally
divided amongst them

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my son in law Jessie
Bails five Shillings Virginia Money to be paid out of
My estate to him and his heirs for ever

Item I Give and bequeath unto my daughter in law
Sara Rachel Bull five Shillings Virginia Money to her
and her heirs for ever & Item I do desire that my
apprentice Adam Clegg and his mate John Smith
may be informed that the same may be settled
amongst my wife and children without any notice given
as but that the same may stand in full and faciliade
as here —

Item I do declare Constitution and Appoint my two sons
Thomas and Henry Bull to be executors of this my last
Will and Testament, Item I appoint my two sons
Thomas and Henry Bull to pay off all funeral charges
and to be paid out of my Estate to Thomas & Bull ~~his~~ ^{the} Bull
Item Publish and Seal this to be my last Will &
Testament this 22 day of May A.D. 1768 —

in presence of us John Luckaby his mark John Lett
Rott Whilaker his mark

Then this Will was presented in open Court and made by
the Testators and duly proved by the oaths of John Lett
+ Robert Whilaker two of the Subscribing Witnesses
whereof who in their oaths did say they saw John
Alcock sign the said Will as he witness, whereupon
Thomas Bull one of the Testators in the said Will
made present into Court and was duly qualifyed
by taking the oath by Law directed on M^r Justice Ordred
