 I now Live on to her and her heirs for ever.
 Item I give and bequeath to my son Edward Jackson the Land & Plantation
 now Live on to him & his heirs for ever.
 Item I give unto my Loving wife Mary Jackson the Gray Colt that came of
 my Little Gray Mare & got by Red horse to her & her heirs for ever.
 Item And my will and Desire for all the Rest of my Estate ^{not} already given
 away but of what kind or Nature ever to be Equally divided between
 my three Children Sarah Jackson, Edward Jackson & Judy Jackson their

I shall a Like to them & their heirs for ever.
I do hereby Appoint my Friend Lewis Williamson & my Loving
Brother William Jackson, Executors of this my Last will & Testament
