forty Shillings to John Drayton his wife, Lastly I appoint
my loving Wife Lucy Langley, Executrix to my said Estate
Executor of this my last Will and Testament, and do
hereby invest her, with Authority, to dispose to sell & convey
the same, and do hereby disannul every other former Will &
Testament, I do ratify & confirm this, and do execute
my last Will & Testament, On witness whereof I have
hereunto set my Hand and Seal the ninth day of January
in the Year of our Lord 1764 T. Langley ^{Seal} Signed Sealed
