my loving Wife Lucy Langley, Executor ~~my~~ James Smith
Executor of this my last Will and Testament, and do
hereby invest them, with Authority, and power to sell & convey
the same, and do hereby disannul every other former Will &
Testament, & do ratify & confirm this, and none but to be
my last Will & Testament, In Witness Whereof I have
hereunto set my Hand and Seal the ninth day of January
in the Year of our Lord 1764 T. Langley Signed Sealed
