thereunto belonging I give the said Thomas Pope and his heirs ~~of~~

Hesitancy the third and last part of his inheritance to be for my Son James Pope
and his heirs and assigns for ever. Item, I give and bequeath to
my Son James Pope all my Copper Irons brass & copper and the like
with all her increase that ite entwoold haue. Item, I give to my Son
Stephen Pope all my Blakes, with the Irons and the Cud and Calf
and one Horse and Pigg and one Gun and one dish and four
Spoons. Item, I give and bequeath to my Daugher Sally Pope the leather
Bed and featherbed and one Sonet Bed or Post. Item, I give and bequeath
to my Daugher wife Constance Pope all and every thing that I had with
her whelked here or elsewhere to her only Soner and I Item, I give
my Daugher wife Constance Pope the third of the Plantation houses
I now live. During her Natural life and Widowhood. Item, my Will

is that all the remainder of my estate that is not apportioned in Seg-
sies, may be equally divided amongst all my children. That is Ann
Elain Thomas Pope the elder, Robert Pope Patience Benetton, Mary
Bailey Jesse Pope James Pope Abiah Pope Thomas Pope the younger
Jesup Pope, and that all the remainder of my estate set aside the
separately, be divided amongst all my children before mentioned by the
proportion of my estate of hereafter mentioned. Lastly I do appoint
my sons William Pope and Thomas Pope the Elder witness and to all
my executors and for us this my last Will and Testament hereby I
doe allow and make of my seal and affix thereto this day of July in the
year of our Lord 1760 & signed Sealed Published Recommended
by the said Thomas Pope to his trusty Will and Testament
