In the Name of God Amen, I Thomas Turner of the County of Halifax & State of S^c Carolina, Being sick & weak in Body, but in Sound & perfect Memory, Thanks be to God, but calling to mind the mortality of Man kind & knowing it is appointed for all Men once to die, Do make certain Constitute & appoint this my last Will & Testament, following (Wiz^t —)
First — I give & bequeath unto my loving Wife Sarah Turner & to her heirs, my Plantations, whereon I now live, & all the Land belonging thereto.
Item: I Give & bequeath to my loving Wife Sarah Turner, & her Heirs on Negroes named Ned, I also give & bequeath unto my loving Wife Sarah Turner, & to her heirs the Remainder of my whole Estate Consisting of Hogs, Horses, Cattle, Household & Kitchen Furniture, with all the Crop that is now growing —
Item: Lastly I nominate, constitute & appoint my loving wife Sarah
