I do desire that worldly goods it has pleased God to bless me with to be equally divided between my two Children my Daughter Mary Winters and my Son Perry Winters, and that it may be the more equally divided I do desire it may be sold and so divided between my two Children above mentioned. And as touching my Brother who is now growing, I do desire my beloved Brother James Winters to finish and to sell it and to discharge my debts with and what is over paying my debts to be put to the use of my Children at the discretion of my beloved Brother James Winters mentioned, and I do also appoint and ordain my beloved Brother James Winters
