Memory, Thanks be given to God, for the same, and calling to Mind The
mortality of the Body, and knowing that it is appointed for Men,
once to Die, do make, and ordain, this my last Will & Testament, that
is to say, as touching such worldly Estate, wherewith it hath pleased
God to Bless me, I give, Devise, and Dispose of the same in manner,
and form following.

In the first place I give & Bequeath to my Beloved Son, John
Ives the Land and Plantation, wherupon I now live, containing One Hun-
dred & Seven Acres, which was Granted to me by Deed from Nicholas
Hamilton, to him & his Heirs for ever.

Item. I give and Bequeath to my Beloved Son Timothy Ives, all that
Land, and Plantation, which was granted to me by Deed from Griffin Morris
containing One Hundred Acres be the same more or less, To him & his Heirs
for ever.

Item. My Will and Desire is that my Beloved Wife Dinah Ives shall
have the use & Privilege of all my Land above mentioned, in the same

In the first place I give & Bequeath to my Beloved Son, John

Item. My Will and Desire is that my Beloved Wife Dinah Ives shall
have the use & Privilege of all my Land above mentioned, in the same
manner, as if it was her own property, during the Time of her widow-
hood, and also I leave all the Rest of my Estate to her during the Time
of her Widowhood. But if she marries my Will is, that all my move-
able Estate, shall be Equally Divided between her & my Six Children,
Share and Share alike. But if my Wife continues Single during
the Time of her Life: then after her Death my Desire is that my

(192.) moveable Estate, be equally divided between My Six Children each one
to have an Equal Part. I do hereby constitute, and Ordain my Beloved Wife
Dinah Jones Executrix, and my Friends Josephiah Morris William
Hadaaway, and Jesse Read Executors of this my last Will & Testament
and I do hereby utterly Disallow, revoke, and Disannull, all former
Wills by me made, ratifying & Confirming this & no other, to be my last
