Acres of Land it being the plantation whereon I now live & him
& his heirs for ever, and my desire is that my wife Mary Stone shall
have the use of it during her Natural life.

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary Stone one feather
bed & furniture & three Cows & Calves

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Anne Stone furniture
furniture & three Cows & Calves my Will & Desire is that my property
may be equally divided between my son Isaac Stone & my two
daughters Mary Stone & Anne Stone Item I give to my son Thomas
Stone one Hilling Sterling Item I give to my son William Stone one
Hilling Sterling, Item I give to my daughter Winifred Bradge
one Hilling Sterling, Item I give to my daughter Bernethony
one Hilling Sterling, Item I send to my beloved wife Mary Stone all
the remainder of my estate that is not already mentioned

during her life & then my desire is that it return to my son Isaac
Stone to him & his heirs for ever & it is my Will & Desire that the true
intent & meaning hereof by a due performance shall prevail upon my

estate & the several exceptions & provisos herein contained
hereby shall be taken away & abrogated all former
wills by me made & further more I do constitute and appoint my
dear wife Mary Stone & Isaac Stone Executrix of this my last Will
& Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& sign my seal the day of the month of April 1758

Shilling Sterling, Item I give to my daughter Winifred Headge
one Hilling Sterling, Item I give to my daughter Bessy Bartholomew
one Hilling Sterling, Item I send to my beloved wife Mary House all
the remainder ^{part} of my estate that is not already mentioned
Having her life & then my desire is that it return to my son Isaac
House to him & his heirs for ever & it is my Will & desire that the time

estate & the several exceptions to no person or persons mentioned
hereby shall be taken concerning & disannulling all former
Wills by me made further more I do constitute and appoint my
living wife Mary House & Isaac House Extra of this my last Will

Halifax Co January 1st Comt 1763 there this Will was exhibited

Mary House & Isaac House Esq^r in this^d name was qualified
