In the name of God Amen, I William Lowe Junr of Halifax County in the Province of North Carolina, being sick & Weak but of a Sound Memory & Understanding, thanks be to God for the same, and as for my worldly goods & Chattels that it hath pleased God to bless me with, I Will & bequeath in manner following. Item I lend to my beloved Wife Sally Lowe my Land whereon I now live, during her Widowhood, to raise my Children upon & when my Children comes off age, my desire is that my Land should be Equally divided among them. Item the remaining part of my Estate to be sold by my Executors hereafter mentioned, my lawful debts being first paid, & if any thing left, to be equally divided among my Children. Item I constitute & Appoint my beloved Wife Sally Lowe Executor, & my trusty friend Figures Lewis Executor of this my last Will & Testament, utterly revoking & disannulling all Other Wills & Testaments that may by me formerly have been made; And in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal, this twenty fourth day of April, in the Year of our Lord Christ, One thousand Seven hundred & ninety Three.
