Charges be first paid Item I give & bequeath to my well beloved wife Martha Numeruf all the lands  
Stock of every kind household Goods & Furniture that I now possess to her disposal. I appoint my well  
beloved wife Martha Numeruf, Henry Pickens, John Taylor & John Cooper to be my Executors to this my last will  
& Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty seventh day of April 1799.

being in perfect sound mind & memory do make & declare this to be my last will & Testament in  
manner & form following (that is to say) I give all the property of every kind I am now possessed of  
my wife during her widowhood. except the Tract of land purchased of John Richards, which I wish to be sold  
under to discharge my debts. I give & bequeath to my son in law Thomas Hales five Shillings Sterling. In  
will & desire at the death of my wife that all the property then remaining shall be sold and the money  
arising therefrom to be equally divided among George Hubank, Joseph Hubank & Harry Jones  
healy nominate constitute & appoint Thomas Hales & my son George Hubank to be Executors of this  
last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
