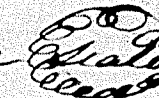

William Parman Coe Will

In the Name of God Amen I William Parman of the County of Halifax State of North Carolina do make & declare this Instrument to be
my last will & Testament touching all others - I do all of my Just debts are to be
paid as soon as provision can be made for the same - I then I give & bequeath
unto my loving wife Elizabeth Parman the use of my whole plantation dur-
ing her natural life or widowhood & then to be disposed of in the manner
herein after mentioned - I then I give & bequeath to my daughter James, Ketch
manning five shillings to be raised out of my estate - I then I give & bequeath
to my daughter Elizabeth Parman five shillings to be raised as above
I then I give & bequeath to my son Orrin Davis Parman my bay Colt called Tom
my will and desire is that my personal estate of every description (after my debts
shall be paid) (otherwise than the legacy before mentioned) and out of the
money arising from such sale together with the debts that are due me my debts
are to be paid and the residue if any I have to be equally divided between
my wife Elizabeth Parman my daughter Mary Ann Condit & my three sons to wit
William Kite Parman, William William Parman & Orrin Davis Parman my further

my further will and desire is that at the decease or marriage of my wife my plantation should be sold by my Executors on such a Credit as they may think most advantageous and the money arising from such sale I have to be equally divided between my three sons as before named but in case of the decease of either or two of them before they arrive to the full age of twenty one years or before they have an heir lawfully begotten my will & desire is that that survivor or survivors of them may have the whole. Lastley I constitute and appoint John Lewis & my son Whitwell Hill Parman my Executors to this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have here unto set my hand & seal this 27th day June 1800
