

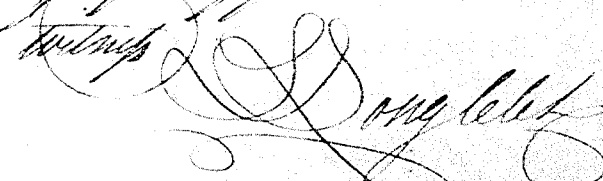
Wm Perkins will

In the Name of God Amen, I William Perkins Jun. of the County of Halifax State of North Carolina being aware of being but of perfect sound mind & memory do this 14th day of April ~~1801~~ in the year of our Lord 1801 make & publish this to be my last will & Testament in the manner & form following (to wit.) Then I give and bequeath to my beloved wife one feather bed & furniture one Cotton wheel, one Hoghead of Cotton, one Cow stool one Chair, one ff. Cotton Cards, one small pot and a parcel tinware & Tin ware and one Case of Knives & forks and one Tea table, and one Canister etc. Then I give to my beloved daughter Polly all the tract of Land that I am now possessed of. Then I will that her all the rest of my moveable property to be sold and all my Just debt to be paid and the balance of money to my daughter Polly. Then I do nominate & appoint Hezekiah Morris & Henry Perkins Jun to be Executors to this my last will & Testament and I do hereby annul and revoke all former Wills heretofore made by me and do publish this to be my last will & Testament in the presence of
