I Give & bequeath to my daughter Sarah five pounds proclamation money to Give her a year schooling. and my Will is that my Negro fellow Jim shall be sold for ready money & my Desire is that the rest of my ~~money~~ ^{estate} Real and Personal shall be sold and I will that Credit Given for the payment of the money and when my debts and funeral Expenses are paid the rest of the money to be Equally divided among my Children to be paid into Legall Interest when they Come to the age of Twenty one Years or when they marry if they marry before. My Desire is that my daughter Sarah remain in the Care of Ruth Shelton till she is Twenty one years old or marries and my daughter Elizabeth remain in the Care of Betty Lewis till she is Twenty one Years old & I do further appoint Sademar Shelton and David Lane Executors of this my Last Will and Testament Renouncing all other Wills by me made before the Date hereof Given under my hand this 28th Day of August 1771
