North Carolina being weak in body but of Sound Memory & of good Understanding do
hereby make & Ordain my last Will and Testament in Manner & form as follows. Item
It is my will & Desire, That all my Just & Lawful debts should be paid; My land & plan-
tation Stock & every kind of my thing due that I possess I give to my Wife Patsy
Smith. And I desire that my Friend William Rose, should Act & do my business
for me. As Writings Thereto do set my hand and Seal this 9th Day of February
1792
