County of Haywood in the State of North Carolina Being of sound
& perfect mind & Memory (Blessed be God) do this sixth day of
February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred &
seventeen Make & publish this my Last will & Testament in
Manner and form following (that is to say)

first I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Hannah the
use and benefit of all the personal property I am possessed of
after my just debts are paid for and during her Natural &
Life widowhood, and also that she be supported on the planta-
tion, and have the house I live in for the term above set forth

Secondly I give and bequeath to my Oldest Son Jeremiah Hyatt a body
cow & calf with such property as I have heretofore bequeathed him
with

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my Oldest Daughter Sarah the
wife of William Allen the sum of One Dollar with such
property as I have heretofore given her

fourthly I give and bequeath to my son Eliza Hyatt One Dollar
with such property as I have heretofore given him

fifthly I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Young wife of
Joseph Young the sum of One Dollar and such property as
I have heretofore given her

Sixthly I give devise & bequeath to my son Nathan Hyatt and his
heirs forever one hundred acres of land lying and being in
said County of Haywood on the Conny fork of Frenchs Fork River

was a young Negro Girl named Belle the Oldest Child of my Negro
woman and it is further my will & devise that if my Negro
woman should hereafter have another Child that may live to
the decease of my beloved wife that I will the same to my
said son Nathan Hyatt and his heirs forever also a horse of a
reasonable value or the Gray horse which he now has in his possession
also such other property as I have heretofore bequeathed him with
heretofore I give and devise to my Youngest son Abi Hyatt and to
his heirs forever the tract of land on which I now reside after his
mothers decease in the said Abi supporting and maintaining her
during her Natural Life or widowhood, and as I have stated in
the first part of this instrument that my beloved wife is to be
supported on the plantation yet should it so happen that her life
be prolonged until my said son Abi Hyatt may marry or
such event then it is my will and devise that my said son Abi have
the use & benefit of the said plantation by giving her a sufficient
allowance sufficient with such stock and Negroes as she may be in the
possession of, and further should it so happen that my son Nathan
be put off the Indian land where he is now settled, and is willing,
location he is to have a reasonable lease if he chooses the same
on that part of my tract of land at and above the old stone house
until he can settle himself elsewhere, and further it is my will
and devise that after my said wife's death that the whole of my
property except what is specially given away in the former
part

part of this will immediately descend and become the property of my said son Able Hyatt and his heirs forever -

and furthermore I do by these presents nominate constitute & appoint my Beloved wife Hannah Hyatt & my two Sons Eliza & Able together with my friend Robert Love of said County Executors of this my Last Will & Testament; and I do by these presents publish and declare this and none other to be my Last Will & Testament, hereby revoking dissolving and disannulling all and every former or other will or Testament by me heretofore made
