Beaver George Vincent place Lumber
Lori something given him to R.D. Demand
B.B. Francis Mr. Liner who after being duly
Sworn according to law proceeded on the
25th day of July A.D. 1861 in audience
to the accused, went to lay off and allot to
successors of Pope's down & third in the
lands of her deceased husband Robert Pope
