

Gideon Allman Will

In the Name of God Amen

I Gideon Allman of the County of Haywood and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and disposing memory and knowing that it is appointed for man once to die, do make publish and declare this and thus only to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows (to wit)

First I Will my soul to God who gave it, and my body to the dust from whence it came, To be decently buried

Secondly I Will and bequeath to my beloved wife Margaret all the Tract of Land on which I now live together with all appurtenances thereto belonging, Also one Negro Boy named Isaac Also two heads of furniture two Tables one large and a small one one Bearon + one Pattern Clock half a dozen Chairs one large Cupboard and as much of the dresser furniture and cooking utensils as she may desire Also one hundred Dollars in cash which is now on hand Also six head of hogs of her choice and a sufficient quantity of grain for her support for one year And one Milk Cow of her choice all of which is to be heirs during her natural life and after her death to be sold and divided as herein after described Thirdly My Will is that my son Payton shall not be charged with the Piece of the Land which I have heretofore deeded to his heirs, having heretofore given to each of my other children equal amounts with him in land and money

Fourthly I Will and bequeath to my daughter in law Mary Allman widow of my son Wm Allman or sold twenty Dollars which is all I intend her to have of my estate

Fifthly I Will and bequeath the children and heirs of my son William Allman three hundred dollars to be equally divided between them share and share a like which is all I intend them to have of my estate

Sixthly I Will that the remainder portion of my property be sold and the proceeds of sale and debts on hand to be equally divided between the following heirs share and share a like (to wit)

My son John R. Allman Nelson Allman Payton Allman W. L. Allman and daughter Elizabeth McHoffey and Mary Frances wife of William Frances and the heirs of Thompson Allman decd

intended before signed I Also constitute and appoint my trusty friend Walter Brown executor to this my last will and testament in which whereof I the said Gideon Allman hath hereunto set my name and affixed my seal this the 25th day of my A.D. 1857
