

Gideon Allman Will

In the Name of God Amen

I Gideon Allman of the County
of Haywood and State of North Carolina being of sound
Mind and disposing memory And Knowing that it is
Appointed for Man once to die do make publish and
Declar this and this only to be my last Will and Testement
in manner and form as follows (to wit)

1st First I Will my soul to God who gave it and my
body to the dust from whence it came To be
 decently buried

2nd Secondly I Will and bequeath to my beloved wife
Margaret all the tract of Land on which we now
live together with all appertinances thereto belonging
Also one Negro Boy named Isaac Also two beds
furniture two Tables one large and a small one
one Beacon & one Patten Clock half a dozen chairz
one large Cupboard and as much of the deeper furniture
and Cooking Utencils as she may desire Also one
hundred Dollars in cash which is now on hand
Also six head of hogs of her choice and a sufficient
Quantity of grain for her support for one year
And one Milk Cow of her choice all of which is to
be heirs during her natural life and after her
death to be sold and divided as herein after described

Thirdly My Will is that my son Payton shall not be
charged with the piece of the Land which I have
heretofore deeded to his heirs having heretofore
given to each of my other children equal amounts
with him in land and money

Fourthly I Will and bequeath to my daughter in law
Mary Allman widow of my son Wm Allman in law
Twenty dollars which is all I intend her to have
of my estate

Fifthly I Will and bequeath the children and heirs
of my son William Allman three hundred dollars
to be equally divided between them shear
and shear alike which is all I intend
them to have of my estate

Sixtly I Will that the remainder portion of my property
be sold and the proceeds of sale and debts on hand
to be equally divided between the following heirs
Shear and shear alike (to wit)

My son John R. Allman Nelson Allman Payton Allman
W. L. Allman and daughter Elizabeth Mohoffer and
Mary Frances wife of William Frances and the heirs of
Thompson Allman dead
interlined before signed

I also constitute and appoint my trusty friend
Walter Brown executor to this my last will and testament
in witness whereof I the said Gideon Allman hath
hereunto set my name and affixed my seal this the
25 day of my A.D. 1857

Hugh Brown Will

In the Name of God Amen

I Hugh Brown of the County of
Haywood and State of North Carolina
Being diseased in body but of a sound and disposing
mind and memory do make this my last Will and testament
reoking all former wills by me made

1st I Will that my executors herein after named procure
for my body a decent burial and pay my funeral
expenses out of the first money that may come into his
hands as part or parcel of my estate

2nd I Will that my executors pay all my just debts
to whomsoever owing out of my estate as soon as the
money can be procured to do so

Item 5th I will and bequeath to my wife Caroline the place whereon & plantation on which I now live including both sides of the Creek and to be under her control and for her use and the use of our children during her natural life

Item 6th I will to my wife Caroline all my stock of horses Cattle Hogs Sheep & Farming tools Wagons &c to be for her use and benefit and the benefit of our children

Item 5th At the death of my wife Caroline as it is my will that all the property of which heretofore is mentioned kind & manner that may be in her possession be divided among my children according to law

Item 6th I hereby constitute and appoint my wife Caroline Brown my executor to execute this my last will & testament given under my hand and seal this signed & sealed in presence of Hugh Brown Esq^r & of us who at the testator's request Hugh Brown Esq^r & in his presence subscribed

Isaac McAbie Will

After giving my soul to god who gave it

I Isaac McAbie A. M.th of the County of Haywood in the state of N. C. Carolina being of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following (to wit)

I give and devise to my beloved wife Martha McAbie one hundred and 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres of Land known and is the farm where I now live adjoining the lands of Robert Rogers so as to include the house and improvement wherein I now live to have and to hold to her the said Martha McAbie for and during the term of her natural life in satisfaction for and in view of her labor and trouble of and in all my real estate and further I also devise to my said beloved wife Martha McAbie all my house hall and Kitchen furniture and my farming tools during her natural life and further after death of my said wife Martha McAbie I give and devise to my two sons Isaac McAbie Jr and Eber McAbie all the above stated tract of Land with the improvements thereon Isaac McAbie to hold the lower end and Eber McAbie the upper end to be equally divided between them

In witness whereof I the said Isaac McAbie do hereto set my hand and seal this the 30th day of March in the year of our Lord 1858 signed sealed published & declared by the said Isaac McAbie his last Will ^{and} Testament In the presence of us who at his request and his pleasure do subscribe our names
