lord 1859, make and publish this my
last will and testament in manner
as follows that is to say first I give and
bequeath unto my brother and sisters
to wit Mathew Maylin Ann Maylin
Emarella Maylin Zilla Maylin Ennarella
Maylin Rutha Maylin all my lands
without reserve; Secondly I will
that my slave be sold to pay the doctor fee
and should that over pay him I will
and bequeath the remainder to the same
above named; Thirdly I give and bequeath
the to Mathew Maylin all my tools both
for house and farming; Fourthly
I give and bequeath to those above named
all my ready money and papers and
undying money; Fifth I give and
bequeath to Jesse Maylin my overcoat;
Sixth I give and bequeath unto John
Maylin the overcoat of John Maylin and
Seventh I give and bequeath to George
V. Maylin my Rifle gun; And
I hereby make and ordain my worthy friend
Mathew Maylin Executor of this my last will
and testament; In witness whereof I the said
George V. Maylin have to this my last
will and testament set my hand
and seal this day and year above
written
