lands & are particularly described in
an agreement entered into between
John Casey & Jas W Duval about the
30th of November 1876. Recorded and
Registered in said County in Book No
13 on pages 397 & 398 - Also all my right
title and interest in a certain tract
of Land containing about twenty five
acres which I hold under a contract from
C. B. Justice of Redmond & Scott dated
16th December 1880 - Said Land adjoining Casey
& Hill - The said Adaline Duval I have
& to hold & enjoy all the above described
property during her natural life & at her
death to be equally divided equally between
my three children to wit Louisa J. Doney, Mary
Duval & James P Duval - My daughter Margaret
Bile has been advanced heretofore & not made
a devise under this will -

I hereby appoint my wife Adaline
Duval sole executrix of this my last will
and testament with full power and
authority to manage control and wind
up my estate in & concerning said estate in
such manner as she may think proper
