And memory for which I desire that my Property  
Be disposed of as follows 1st I desire that my  
Funeral Expenses Paid & and I desire all my  
Just Debts Be paid out of the sale of my  
Property I wish my Executors to sell my Land  
Which I know lies ~~here~~ or other by publice sale or  
Private which ever they may think best and also  
wish all of my Property sold either by publice or Private  
Sale which ever my Executors think best for which I desire  
That my Executors Do sell as much of my Property as will  
fully pay off my debts and then all the balance of my  
Estate I give unto my beloved wife for her to have and to  
do as she may think proper also for her to keep as much  
of the house hold furniture at the wants and if more than  
the wants be sold in like manner all my Property to be  
sold at Publice or private sale usinng Executors judgment may  
think best to do I hereby nominate my beloved wife and  
My son Davis C. Hodges my Executors to this my last  
Will and Testament and also Revoking all other  
Wills heretofore made by me at any in witness where  
of I have here unto set my hand and seal this  
26<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord one  
Thousand Eight hundred and forty Nine
