

In the name of God Amen I Robert Hill of the County of Henderson and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory and considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory life do therefore make known publish and declare this to be my last will and testament out that is to say first after all my lawful debts is paid and discharged the residue of my estate real and personal I give bequeath and dispose of as follows to wit to my beloved wife the land and appurtenances where I now live together with all my other property real & personal stock of cattle and sheep and hogs and swine together with all household and kitchen furniture together with the crops of corn and all other kinds of grain and vegetables and also all my money and notes likewise I make constitute and appoint my wife Nancy R. Hill to be my executor of this my last will & testament hereby Rescinding all former Wills by me made. Now the enactment of this will is such that if Nancy R. Hill survives then there is to be no administrator appointed by the Court and all the above named property and effect is to be sold and divided between my lawful children but one dollar to her. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal the fourteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two

 my worthy friend Aaron Capps Executor of
