Will I Give to my wife and the sons to be Equally Divided
Between them after my wife shall Manj until then she do
to have the use of it to Bring up my Children and young people
with any Expence against my Children and Lastly I appoint
my wife Margret Holmell Executrix and George Barron Esq^r
to this my Last Will and Testament in witness whereof I
have hereunto set my Hand and seal this fifteenth day
of December Annus Domini 1784.

Memory do put this my Last Will and Testament in writing as follows
I Give to my Beloved wife Elizabeth Ebome during her Widowhood
my whole Estate Both real and personal after her marriage I leave my
Personal Estate to be Equally Divided Between my said wife and my
Eight Children which Estate I Give to them and their heirs except my say
which negroes after my wife's death or marriage I Give as follows
I Give to my son Youth Ebome one negro Boy named Nerica
I Give to my son Aaron Ebome one negro Boy named Peter
I Give to my son Littleton Ebome one negro Boy named Stephen
which said negro Boy Stephen I Give to my said son Littleton and
his Brother Edmund Ebome to them and their heirs.

I Give devise and Bequeath to my two sons Littleton Ebome and
Edmond Ebome the plantation where our now live and the Land
thereunto Belonging to them and their heirs for ever the said Land to be
Equally Divided between as follows Beginning on the main Creek
in the middle of the Land running a Crope the Land to the Rock Line
Littleton to have the Lower part for his share of said Land
I Give to my four Daughters viz Elizabeth Anna Manning and
Rebecca Ebome three young negroes to wit Rose Effie and Arabon
to them and their heirs to be Equally Divided between them when my
daughters Rebecca & Anne to the age of Eighteen years my will is
that the said negroes Last mentioned be in the possession and care
of my two eldest Daughters them and their increase until the
Division be made as above mentioned.

Lastly I appoint Geo Barron Youth Ebome and Aaron
Ebome Executors to this my Last will and Testament And I am
whom of their heirs unto set my hand and seal this fourteenth
day of December A.D. 1784.

 Hyde County I day of March one thousand eight hundred
 and Eighty Five, I Benjamin Jewell of the County of Hyde of sound
 and State of North Carolina Being of the Body, But of sound
 Mind and perfect Memory thanks be given to God therefor calling
 to mind the Mortality of my Body knowing that it is appointed
 for all men once to dye do make and Ordain this my last Will and
 Testament in manner and form following viz, First of all I
 Give and recommend my Soul into the Hands of God that Give
 it and my Body to the Earth from Whence it was taken
 to be Buried in such Decent and Christian Manner as
 my Executors hereafter named shall think meet and convenient
 and as touching such worldly Estate as the Lord in his mercy
 hath sent me I Give and Devise and Dispose of the Same in
 manner and form following first to sell Renouncing
 Disannulling and making Void all wills and
 Bequests by me Heretofore named or made ratifying
 and Confirming this Same and no other to be my last
 Will and Testament.

 my forces and followers and the use of my plantation to my wife
 Elvira and Mary Jewell during her widow hood.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my son Ebenezer Jewell one negro Girl
 named Felice and one Dast and one Bed and some household
 and if he the said Ebenezer Jewell dye with out Heir of his Body
 that they shall be Equally divided amongst all the remaining children

Item I Give and Bequeath to my daughter Dina Sully one negro
 wench named Frances to her and her Heir for Ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my daughter Fededah Jewell one negro
 Girl named Vilete and one feather Bed and some Covering
 to her and her Heir for Ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my daughter Frances Worden my negro
 Boy named Isaac to her and her Heir for Ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my daughter Fannima Jewell one negro
 Girl named Rosanna to her and her Heir for Ever.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my son Ebenezer Jewell all my land
 Between Highgate Line as my Deed doth more fully

Show to him and his Heir for Ever.
