disposing mind and memory thanking to all mightly God for it calling to mind
the mortality of Body & knowing that it is now appointed for me once to
die, I do make & ordain constitute & appoint this to be my last will and
testament in manner & form following, Revoking and Disannulling
all other will or wills by me made. — First, I do wish my Brother
Adam Lay my negro woman called Hannah for the use of Bringing
up & keeping of daughter Nancy Mason in a decent & Christian like form
and to school her as far as reading & writing and if she will not do
it for that, then any other person that will do the same kind of office
for my Daughter have a right to take my Daughter Nancy Mason
and my worded from hence that will comply with my Desire, until
she arrives to the age of Eighteen or in marriage, Secondly
I give and bequeath unto my Brother Adam Lay all my
husband will give and all my other of my goods & chattels both
within doors and without Conditionally that if my daughter
Nancy Mason dies before she arrives to the age of Eighteen years
or without her otherwise if my Daughter Nancy Mason dies before
she arrives to the age of eighteen years, or dies of her body living then
my will and Desire is they or either of them or them do live and
Enjoy and take to their own use to them and their heirs for ever all the above
Conditional gift from hence to said Adam Lay — — —

Wholly give and Bequeath unto my brother Adam Lay all my real
and Personal. — Lastly I do appoint my Brother Adam Lay my
sole & sole Executor to this my last and testament. In witness
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 24th Day of
