In the Name of God Amen I Bethel Bailey of the County of Hyde
in North Carolina being very sick and weak but of a sound mind
and memory thankfull to God do make and ordain this my last
Will & Testament and as touching my worldly estate I give devise
and dispose of the same in the following manner and form
First I Give & Bequeath to my Beloved wife Mary Bailey a good and
sufficient maintenance unto my Estate during her natural life
or during her widowhood

Item I Give & Bequeath to my daughter Ann Hardison four Shillings
to be paid by my Executors here after mentioned

Item I Give & Bequeath to my daughter Eliza Sinton for Shillings
in addition to what she has received all Ready

Item I Give & Bequeath to my daughter Barbara Bellour bow and Coff

Item I Give and Bequeath to my daughter Mary Bailey for Shillings

Item I Give and Bequeath to my daughter Margaret Bailey Ten Pounds
to be paid by my Executors

Item I Give and Bequeath to my daughter Sarah Bailey for Shillings
and also a maintenance of my Estate till she is of age or manhood

Item I Give and Bequeath to my daughter Morning Bailey ten pounds
to be laid out in her Schooling

Item I Give and Bequeath to my daughter Imloe ten pounds to be
appropriated to her Schooling

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Son Samuel Bailey the Plantation
on which I now live containing the whole Island together with
all the Buildings thereon Standing even

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Son Bethel Bailey three hundred
acres of Land lying on Pamlico River it being the same
I purchased of John Williams

Item I further Give and Bequeath to my sons Samuel & Bethel
Bailey all and Every part or parcel of my Estate Personal
in doore and out consisting of Notes Bonds book acc'ts
Stock of Cattle Horses Sheep & hogs house hold furniture
Farming utensels & to be equally divided between them

It is my will and desire that my Lot of Land in Wash-
ington and a Lot of Land at Wards Point containing about thirty
acres both Should be Sold as soon after my decease as
may be by my Executors and converted Equally to the use of

my sons Samuel and Bishuel Bailey whom I make & ordain together with Thomas Windley Executore to thir my Last will and Testament here by disannulling all former will or testaments whatsoever Ratifying and Confirming this & neither as my Last will and Testament herevirsse whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this nineteenth day of September anno Domini 1790 --

Hyde County
In the Name of God amen I Thomas Gaylord of the Age
Country being in proper health perfect mind and memory
Calling to mind Mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed
for all men once to die I do make & ordain this my last will &
Testament & first of all I recommend and my soul in
the hands of God that gave it me and my body to be decently
buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned
and as for what worldly goods it has pleased God
to bless me with after my funeral Expenses is paid I give

I give and bequeath m^r and form as follows with Testimoniis.
I bequeath my well beloved wife Rosannah Gaylord my
Dwellinghouse and plantation and the other houesing with
fifty acre of Land and one Negro boy named Peter but not
to be hired out without consent of my executors and all my Stock
of Cattle & Hogs are at one horse & one plow and my Stock of Bees to
use at her Desirous during the term of her widowhood and after
marriage or death the Land to my youngest son to Gaylord and the
Negro boy to be Divided Equally between Thomas Gaylord Stephen
Gaylord Benj Gaylord Winfield Gaylord & James Gaylord
I give & bequeath one Negro girl named Jane to my daughter Mary
Wright Susannah Davis Ann Radcliff & Martha Satterwhite to be
Equally Divided and as for my Stock & household goods to be
Equally Divided between my five sons & four daughters
as for my widow all in the of my to Sons Thomas Gaylord
& James me
I make and ordain my Execution of this my Last will & Testament
Dying and renouncing all other wills or wills or Testaments
acknowledging only given under my hand and Seal this day
and date above written and in the presence of us

The implement of writing was introduced to be and contain the
Last will and Testament of Thomas Gaylord dec^r which was
proved by the oath of Stephen Gaylord & Steven Smith who
Swore that they verily both vid the signing of the said will
was the proper hand writing of the said Thomas Gaylord & so
