I appoint my dearly Beloved Wife Abigail and Joseph Hancock to be Executors to this my Last Will to settle my Estate agreeable to my Will, Dated in Wadsworth this 10th day of November 1772.

In the Name of God Amen I John Clevor of the County of Hyde & Province of North Carolina Sheriff Wright of Perfect mind and memory make this my last Will Testament first I commit my soul to God and my Body to be Buried in a Christian Like manner my Temporal Estate I Bequeath and Dispose of in the following manner (Imprimis) after my Lawfull Debts is paid, I Give and Bequeath unto my Beloved Wife Hannah Clevor the Plantation whereon I now dwell with all my movable Estate paying to each of my children one Shilling Sterling. This is to have the use of all my Estate during her Widowhood and then for the balance to be left on the Plantation for my two Daughters Mary and Sarah Clevor whom I Give the aforementioned Plantation to them their heirs and assigns after my Wife's Widowhood, and the Rest of my Estate to be Equally Divided among my children after my Wife's Widowhood. I bequeath & appoint and W^{ill}

Samuel Davis with my wife Hannah Clevor Executors of this my Last Will and Testament hereby Declare Ratify and Confirm this & our other to be my Last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 14 day of September in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred & seventy three.
