Rose. I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary one Negro girl called Bet
I Give and Bequeath to my daughter Edna one Negro girl called Lucy
I Give and Bequeath to my daughter Hamutal one Negro girl called Hulie

that there be no charge for the same against my Estate, and it is my Will that my Negro man called John Should be sold for to pay my debts and if he should sell for more than will pay all the Remainder to go to the support of my Family — I appoint my dearey Belov'd Wife Abigail and Joseph Hancock to be Executon to this my last Will to settle my Estate agreeable to my Will, dated in Woodstock this 10th day of November 1772.

Perfect mind and memory make this my last Will Testament
first I comitt my soul to God and my Body to be Buried in a
Christian like manner my Impound Estate I Bequeath and
Dispose of in the following manner (Imprimis) after my
Lawfull debts is paid I Give and Bequeath unto my Belov'd Wife
Hannah Clever the Plantation wherein I now dwell with all
my moveable Estate paying to Each of my children one
Hilling Stirling. She is to have the use of all my Estate
During her Widewhood and then for the cattle to be Left on the
Plantation for my two Daughters Mary and Sarah Clever
Thereof I Give the aforementioned Plantation to them During her
Widewhood and the Rest of my
Estate to be Equally Divided among my children after
Widewhood I Bequeath & appoint and Wit
Samuel Davis with my wife Hannah Clever Executon of
this my Last Will and Testament hereby to execute Ratify
and Confirm this & all other to be my last Will and
Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand
and Seal this 14 day of September in the year of Our Lord One
Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty three —
