I give my Wife Elizabeth the Plantation and all the opportunities belonging to it during her Widowhood or Life I secured house as much of my Estate and as would purchase that Piece of Land of Bots of lit should be sold and that with the new name dwell on to be Equally Divided between my Sons James & Shubon and if that is not to be purchased the Land to be Equally Divided between the aforesaid Sons James & Shubon James taking this Plantation and Volantons to have that Piece of Land at the Chapel with the Opportunities the Land on Blounts Creek up the Ford Jun I leave to Samuel the Remainder Part of my Estate I had to my Wife without. Charleston until my said Wife Morris or Dies if in Case my Wife should Marry thus to have one third of my Estate the Remainder of my Estate to be Equally Divided among my Children to be adjusted by William Jasper His Deputy & Jno. Robt. Test.

in the Governor of North Carolina Being weak in Body but of
Sound Memory Blessed be God therefore Do this Twentieth day of
October in the Year one Thousand seven hundred and sixty
Six Make and Publish this my Last Will and Testament in Honour
and praise following that is to say First I Give to my own George
Reed One Shilling Sterling it is my Will and Desire that John
Furnace have the Refusal of the land that I Bequeath with
him for and that my Executors or Executors herein of the Mentioned
Wills the said John Furnace a Debt for the said Land I provided
that the said Furnace apply and pay the Money in three Months
of my Executors Oath or Oaths and Direct that the said
Land be sold to pay my Debt.

Then I give and Bequeath unto my Loving Wife Ann Poole
 One Negro Wench named Flawser and one Negro Girl named
 Kannah and all the Rest and Residue of my Estate both Real
 and Personal — During her Widowhood and then to be Divided Between
 my three Children Samuel Lucy and Mary Shier and Shier Alice
 and I Make and Ordain for my said Wife Sole Executrix of this
 my Last Will in Witness whereof I the said Charles Poole have
 to this my Last Will and Testament set my hand and seal
 the Day and Year above Written
