December in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and ninety five make and ordain
this my last will & Testament in the following
manner and form that is to say —

Item I give and Bequeath to my son Reading Bailey one
hundred acres of land it being the plantation whereon
I dwelt in also my young son more and all my
house Carpenter tools to him and his heirs forever —

Item I give and Bequeath to my daughter Dickey Bailey one feather bed and
bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever —

Item I give and Bequeath to my daughter Mary Bailey one feather bed and
furniture to her and her heirs forever —

Item I give and Bequeath to my daughter Susannah Bailey one feather bed and
furniture being the bed & furniture whereon she dwelt and belongs to her
Item I also leave all the remainder of my estate except my negroes Equally
Divided amongst my four children viz my Daughters Mary Bailey
Reading Bailey & Susannah Bailey to be Divided by my executors
hereafter named —

I leave my legacy to be sold to pay my just debts —
Lastly I have teste and appoint my worthy friend Joshua Bailey
Informer and my friend Ben Norman Executors to this my last
will and testament in witness whereof this the 25th Day of Dec'y
to the my last will and testament set my handt and the
day and year above written.

In the Name of God Amen I James Eborn of Hyde County and State of
North Carolina bring in health and of sound and perfect memory
of mind thanks be God for the same calling to mind the mortality of
my body knowing it is appointed for all men once to die I make and
ordain this my will and testament that is to say First of all I rec-
oncile my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it and
body to be lawfully buried at the discretion of my executors or other
persons here after mentioned something doubtless but at the
resurrection at the last day I shall receive the same thank God to
God for it and for what worthy Estate it hath pleased God to leave
me with, I dispose of in manner following By Preromise,
I give that all my debts and funeral expenses be satisfied and paid —
Item I send to my wife Margaret Eborn my house and all the Land
thereunto Belonging to her free of my oldest Negro and also all
my property that I have not here after mentioned during her
natural life and then to be Equally divided among my six
young children and also my daughter Ann Eborn three children
leaving them a child part Equally divided among the three
be it to them and their heirs for ever —

Item I give and Bequeath to my daughter Ann Eborn one silver dollar in
full of my Estate also I send unto my daughter Ann Eborn two
negroes Jim and Wallace During their natural life to be Equally
Divided between said Ann three children be it to them and their heirs for ever —

Item I give and Bequeath to my son John Eborn one negro man called
Ben and also one negro called Sam after my wife deceased and
also four hundred and fifty acres of land lying in Braggs
County in the fork of Town Creek known by the name of Sandy
Ridge be it to him and his heirs for ever —

Item I give and Bequeath to my son James Eborn one hundred and eighty
acres of land wherein he now dwells also one negro man called
Daniel and also one negro called big Tom after my wife's
decease be it to him and his heirs forever —

Item I give and Bequeath to my daughter Margaret Eborn two negroes
called Little Tom and Liver one bed and furniture and a cow and
calf and to her and her heirs lawfully Begotten of her body

Item I give and Bequeath to my daughter Penelope Eborn three
negroes called Aaron Hanner and Sam, another bed and
continued on next page —

furniture and tools & cattle be left her and her heirs
Lawfully begotten of her body —

Item I give and bequeath to my son Asa Ebom my Plantation and
the Land so far as the first Bay branch at the upper end of my
Plantation with the course out to the Back Line containing two hundred
Acres of Land more or less and also two negroes called
Asa and Bryan be it to him and his heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath to my son Hosea Ebom all the Land between
my very house & be meadow down to the small Creek at the
upper part of my Plantation with the course out to the stream
three hundred acres more or less to him and his heirs forever —
and also give my son Asa Ebom two negroes called George
& Caleb to him and his heirs forever — — —

Item I give Bequeath to my son James Ebom two hundred acres of land
lying in Craven County on back side of fringe swamp and
one Creek but save to it to him his heirs forever — — —

I constitute and appoint, two sons John Ebom and James Ebom
Executors to this my last will and testament Racking all other
wills or wills heretofore I have ever set my hand seal this
11 day January of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred
and ninety seven 1797 — — —

In the name of God, amen I John Evans of Hyde County and State of North Carolina
Being under Body bid of stupring mind and memory blessed be God for it having in mind
the honesteinty of this life and being ordained once for all people to do
make and ordain this my instrument of writing to contain my last will and testament
Decomitting and revoking all other wills and testaments herte for made by me either by
word or writing and the only to be taken as my last will and testament
first that is to say commanding soul to Almighty God that you record my
body to be buried in a Christian manner buried in a Christian it shalld
please my executors to have and to duly execute it hath been pleased God
to bestow me for about my son Asa Ebom and upon him manner and form as
followeth first my will and desire is that all my just debts and funeral charges be
first paid in convenient time after my decease

My will and desire is that my well beloved daughter Neome should have twenty three
acres of Land that has been already laid off for her bying and joining over
Thomas Brooks and all other thing as she is already Promisid to she and her heirs
Lawfully begotten of her body

Also give and bequeath to my well beloved son William Fornman two hundred and
thirty acres of Land beginning at Neomes second corner by a tree Stake
standing in Stephen Brooks line then running with said Brooks line to a
boundary stake in the bunchle from thence the corner still continued
as per a bunchle two hundred and thirty acres running to the sound
as for both ends to be of an equal width to him and his heirs

Also give and bequeath to my well beloved son Jernimie two hundred and
thirty acre of Land beginning at a cedar Stake in the side of the
gald swamp being the division between John's Hole and I'ming
with the course of the patent along the gald swamp against a large
Rock bore part ne near the grane and rising from a large
rock bear partake a course to the bay or hollow as will conclude
two hundred and thirty acres lying on William to him and his heirs
and likewise of give and bequeath to my well beloved son David two hundred
and thirty acres of Land beginning at Jernimie's second corner
and running with the patent as far as will conclude two hundred
and thirty acres running the course of Patent Joining on
Jernimie's lot concluding two hundred and thirty acres to him and his heirs
and Likewise I give and bequeath to my well beloved daughter Ruth of fifty
acres of Land joining of David's to her and hers

Likewise give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Charity
