and touching such Worldly Estate as it hath pleased God
to Bless me with, I Give and Bequeath in manner and form
Following I will and Bequeath to my son Ezekiel Green
fifty acres of Land it being the same where on he now
Liveth. Hence I Give to my Son and Daughter Bridget Sermon
one Bed and furniture. Hence I Give to my Grand Daughter
Bridget Watson one Bed and furniture and two Cows
and Calves and their Increase.

Hence I Give and Bequeath to William Albert one Cow & Her Increase
Hence I Give and Bequeath to my Dear & Beloved wife Bridget
Green the Land and Plantation where on I now live During
Her widowhood as also all and singular my house hold
furniture Stock of Cattle Hogs & Sheep & Except there should any
Disposed & paid up in Her Disease I Give and Bequeath the
said Land and plantation and all my working Tools to my
son David Green and the Rest of my Estate to be Equally
divided Between my four Children and Lastly
Constitute and appoint my sons Ezekiel Green and David
Green whole and sole Executors of this my last will and Testament
and I do hereby Revoke and Disannul all other wills by me
Formerly made Relieving and Confirming this and no
Other to be my last will and Testament in Witness where of
I have hereunto Set my hand and seal this 21st Day
December 1780.

North Carolina State I Rebecca Latham Being sick and weak in Body

Hyde County But of perfect mind and memory do constitute
and order this to my last will and Testament in manner as follows.

I Give to my Beloved wife Sarah Latham During her life or till I die
the following articles that is to say the one half part of the
Plantation and House that I live in one negro woman named
Rachel one negro fellow named Demy one negro fellow named
Bristol Two Feather Beds and Furniture.

I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved son Phineas Latham the one
Half part of a Saw mill and Grist mill on Spring and
and all the privilege there unto Belonging and one negro fellow
named James one negro Boy named Kambo and Bed and Furniture.

I Give to my Beloved son John Latham one plantation and part of
Land the one half part of a Saw mill and Grist mill that I bought
of John Campbell and Richard Evans the use of them his natural
Life and one negro fellow named Snow the use as above mentioned
and after the Death of my son John then the above mentioned Legacies
he go to the said John's heirs Lawfully Begotten of his Body and if the
said John Latham never come to claim any of the above mentioned
Legacies then for them to go to my Grand son Daniel Latham.

I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved son Jesse Latham the plantation
that I now live on and all the Land there unto Belonging and also
the right of one hundred and twenty acres of Land in Whigg
neck together with one Hundred acres of Land that I bought
of John Webster lying next to Woodstock and also fifty acres
of Land that I bought of Arthur Holwell lying next to
Woodstock also one negro fellow named Dick one negro fellow
named Muham and one third part of a Saw mill and Grist
mill lying on Inlet Creek together with one third part
of one Hundred acres of Land joining the said mill
one negro woman named Hannah.

I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved Daughter Mary Martine
one Hundred and fifty acres of Land that I bought of
Arthur Holwell fifty acres of Land that I extend lying
Between Harvey Line and Arthur Holwell's Line one hundred
acres of Land that I patent joining S. Mountrie's Line in
Brights Corner also one third of a Saw mill and
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
