and Isaac Swindell Executors to this my last will &
testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this sixteenth day of March one thousand
seven hundred & ninety three (1793)

Hyde County Being sick and weak of body and knowing the
certainty of Death desire to make this my last will and testament
first I Recommend my soul into the hands of God who gave it
me and my body to be decently buried at the Discretion of
my Executors hereafter mentioned and as to what worldly Estate
as it hath pleased God to bestow on me I Dispose of in man-
ner and form following. — I'mprimis — I advise all my debts
funeral expenses to be fully contracted and paid. I do order that
these negroes should not be sold out of this family of my father —
Item I give and bequeath to my well beloved Brother Hosea Ebom
two hundred and twenty acres of land to him and his heirs for ever —
I give to Ann Ebom to James Ebom and Margaret Ebom and to
Philip Ebom & to Hosea Ebom and to Moses Ebom and all
my worldly goods I have not mentioned and negroes to be
Equally divided among them and the Rest of my Estate that I
posses now or ever shall of my fathers Estate or mine to them
& their heirs for ever. I do constitute and appoint my William
Ebom & Hosea Ebom Exors. of this my last will & testament
and I do hereby revoke all other wills or wills heretofore made I do
hereby publicly declare this to be my last will and testament
In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 13 day of April 1799.
