I do constitute & appoint and ordain Andrick Wilkinson & William Satterthwaite to be my last will & Testament Assigned & Sealed.

De Emriel Chambers Planter being very sick and weak in Body but of Perfect mind and sound Memory for which I thank & bless the Lord; and calling to mind the frailty and mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed to all men once to Die Do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament and principally and first of all

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I Give and Bequeath my Soul into the Hands of God who Give Stand as for my Body I Recommend that it be Buried in a Christian like and Decent manner at the Discretion of my Ex^{rs} nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall Receive the Same again by the mighty power of God. As touching such Worldly Goods or Estate as it shall Please God to Endow & Bless me with in this life I Give and Dispose of them in the following manner and first and foremost I Give and Bequeath to my well Beloved wife Elizabeth Chambers my Plantation where our now live house and both indoors and out I desire her a natural life or Widowedhood Except those Legacies here after mentioned Then I Will and Bequeath to my Son John Chambers the former mentioned Plantation to him beginning at a large Cedar at the Creek Running out to a old Well at the Edge of the old Field along a path taking in the old House, Slately Bought up to the back line joining Aron Chasline so including the Plantation Beginning and then I Will and Bequeath to him one Bed and furniture that he hath now in Possession and a Two year old Heifer

Then I Will and Bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Chambers one Bed and furniture one Cow and Yearling that is now call^d here and one Ewe and one Large Owl Hobb after her mothers Death then I Give & Bequeath to my Son Emriel Chambers the piece of Land I formerly Bought of Jonathan Henry Containing of fifty Acres of Land with the same there on it one Bed and furniture one Ewe and one year and one Two year old Heifer

Then I Will and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Chambers one Bed & furniture one Ewe and one Two year old Heifer one Chest & Bottle case and I bought the Piece of Land I sold to my Son Emriel Chambers and having not paid for the same I desire if I should Die very Shortly before payment be made that John Assist his Brother in paying as far as he can towards the same and that the Remainder be Raised out of my Estate and further neither of the Brothers shall sell his Land but to his Brother and further after their Mothers Death that the Remainder of my Estate be Equally divided amongst all my children and further that I appoint my wife and my sons

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
