 I do appoint my friend Samuel Clark my executor to this
 my Last will & testament January 25th Day 1809
 Witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this Day and date
 above mentioned —

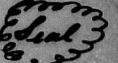

 and all other improvements thereunto belonging one half Dozen
 of Shells her first choice of two feather beds that is two to her with the
 furniture thereunto belonging three barrels of butter one set of
 silver tea spoons and all the bedding ware belonging to the house one
 Round walnut Table one broad or one wedding tin one bedding box
 one flower & glass jar two year old large jar one chest one set of pig
 two wooden wheels one tin wheel one pair cotton one silver first
 choice of bottle, one new shirt one iron pot one oven one still one skillet
 one hundred & fifty weight of sugar twenty five pounds of coffee
 together with all the cruse & brandy & large Jar and butter —
 I appoint my wife Nancy Mallison Joshua Bailey my two executors
 to manage my affairs settling all other wills by me made
 attesting this and no other to be my Last will & testament, I
 witness whereof I have been to set my hand & seal this
 11th Day of February 1809 —
