

In the name of God Amen I Samuel Selby of the County of Hyde and State of North Carolina being in a low State of Health but of perfect Mind and Memory and willing to mind the Mortality of my Body and that it is appointed all men once to Die I Recommend my Soul into the hands of the Almighty God that gave it me and my Body to the Earth to be buried at the Discretion of my Executors and Touching his worldly affairs wherwith it hath pleased God to bless me with I give in the manner & form following that is to say

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Gibbs one Heather Bed and furniture to her and her Heirs for Ever Item I give and Bequeath to my daughter Susannah Jones Two Shillings lawful money to her & her Heirs for Ever Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza Spencer one Negro Boy by the name of Willis to her and her Heirs for ever Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Jane Gibbs one Negro woman by the name of Rose to her and her Heirs for ever Item I give and Bequeath unto my Son Samuel Selby one Negro woman by the name of Pender & one Negro Boy by the name of Bob to him his Heirs and assigns forever Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Spencer Jane Gibbs & my Son Samuel Selby all the Rest of my Estate to be equally Divided between them So that my will and desire is that Samuel Selby my Son Benjamin Spencer & Aunt Gibbs should be Executors to this my last will and Testament Ratifying and Confirming this to be my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth Day of January one thousand Seven hundred & Ninety one

In the name of God Amen I Henry Collings being sick & weak of Body but of a sound Desposing mind and memory Thanks be to God for it Do make and ordain this to be my last will and testament in the manner & form following. That

Item I send to my beloved wife Sarah Collins the plantation whereon I now live during her life or widowhood and after the death or marriage of my wife Sarah Collins then my will and desire is that my Daughter Margaret Smith Collins should have the said plantation

Item I give to my beloved wife Sarah Collins one hundred acres of Land up Spring River which may be known by the name of Bucketers which may be made appear by patent

Item I give to my daughter Margaret Smith Collins all my tools belonging to me one Bed & furniture two young mams Seven head of cattle four flag chairs one chest all my carpenter tools & joiners tools Item I give to my beloved wife Eight head of cattle one Dust one Looking Glass Breakfast & furniture the same belonging one ham & one marr two year old one Loome two wheels one wool one Linen all my hogs except one Sow and pigs to my daughter M. Collins at her marriage if required two small pools two pottmills tea kettle & griddle frying pan two beds and furniture all the com. what must &c. to the present use of my family or for use at two stocks of ~~the~~ ~~the~~ large bed my place

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bus two barrels three Books one chair one Saddle and bridle
 Item I give to my Daughter M. Smith Collies ten Stock of Bees
 one large pot my floor & two here and all my Estate
 that I have not given away already my wish is that
 it be Equally Divided between my wife and my
 Daughter which will appear by Inventory — —
 Also I Constitute and appoint my trusty friend Benjamin
 Spelman my Executor to my wife Sarah Collins my Executrix
 To this my last will and Testament make & hereby do make
 revoke & disallow all other wills by me made Confirming this
 to be my Last will and Testament as witness whereof I
 have signed to set my hand and affix my Seal this 26th
 Day of January 1791 — Signed sealed published and pronounced
 by the Testator in presence of James ^{his} Winfield Henry Collins Seal

 County of Hyde, being infirm in body but in sound and disposing
 mind & memory debonaire and ordain this my last Will and Testament
 in form following that is to say I give and recommend my soul into
 the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my Body I recommend
 to the Earth to be decently interred at the discretion of my Executors
 and further touching such worldly Estate as it shall please God
 to bless me with I will and bequeath in the following manner and form
 I give and Bequeath to my Eldest son Joseph Carrowan one half of all my
 Land and my desire is that he shall have that part of the Land wherein
 my dwelling house now stands together with all the Benefits and
 privileges unto the said Land belonging

Item I give and Bequeath to my son John Carrowan the half of all
 my lands my desire being that he shall have the westernmost end of my
 land joining Peter German's land and with all the privileges that unto
 it pertaining

Item I give and Bequeath to daughter Mary Carrowan one feather bed and
 furniture and my will is that the bed and furniture so disposed
 of shall be deemed so much of the portion that falleth to her and
 not that she should have that much over and above her Equal
 part as shall be hereafter mentioned

Item I give and Bequeath to my dearly beloved wife Frances
 Carrowan all and singular my real & personal Estate during
 her widowhood & no longer and if it should so happen that
 she should marry my will is that all my Estate which is not
 already disposed of to my two sons Joseph & Ephriam Carrowan
 and my daughter Mary Carrowan shall be brought to an account
 or if my wife dies in widowhood that it be brought to an account
 and Equally Divided among my children Joseph & Ephriam
 Carrowan included, those parts being already given and left
 I do constitute and ordain and appoint my wife Frances
 Carrowan Executrix to my son Joseph Carrowan Executrix of
 this my last will and Testament I do hereby revoke and
 disallow all and every other former Testament or will
 by me made Ratifying and Confirming this to be last will
 and Testament ~~reverberate~~ In witness whereof I have
