 cow & one pig Item I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved wife Lucina Allen
 after all my just Debts is paid one third part of all my Estate that is
 not given away already & cow and Lamb Item I Give and Bequeath to
 my Daughter Sarah Allen a Equal part of her my wife's thirds of what
 is Remaining of all God and Chattle Item I Give and Bequeath
 to my Daughter Mary Allen a Equal of the Remainder after my
 Wife thirds with her sister Sarah & all Goods and Chattle lastly
 I ordain constitute and appoint William Brown of Beaufort
 County & Samuel Davis my sole and sole Ex^{or} of this my
 Last will and Testament I do nothing and Revoking all
 the former Wills by me before made & this to stand and Remain
 in full force power & Virtue Given Under my hand and Seal this
 the Day of 14th in the Year of Our Lord 1782
 Signed and sealed

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my well Beloved Mother Mary Juley all
 my whole Estate during her natural Life to use at her own disposal
 and after her Death to be divided Equally amongst her five
 Daughters and I do hereby constitute appoint and ordain my
 Mother Mary Juley and my Brother Law Ruben Slade to be my whole
 Ex^{ors} of this my Last will and Testament
