In the name of God amen, I James Capps of the County of Hyde and State of North Carolina being sick in body but of sound disposing mind and memory do contain make an ordain this my last will and testament in manner as follows following I leave my law full wife Rutha Capps my whole estate both in debt and out debt during her life and natural life or widowhood I give unto my son Thomas Capps one hundred and all my Swearing apparel.
I give unto Daughter Sarah Capps one Sown. I give unto Daughter Lydia Doughty one Linnⁱⁿ Whul^{an} Worlind Whul, I give unto Daughter Pembroke Capps one bed and furniture one Linnⁱⁿ Whul one bed and half and her increase I give unto my son Henry Capps one bed and furniture one large sup^{er} Dish and six plates I give unto son Henry Sampson Capps the plantation whereon I now live and dwell on containing of fifty acres of Land at my wife's continued on next page

death I desire that my Estate shall be Equally divided between my three sons, Thomas Chas^{es} Henry and my three Daughters Sarah Lyde & Pembroke for to be Equally divided all and finally I constitute ordain Joshua Bailey and Thomas Capps and my wife Rutha Capps to be my sole Executors to this my last will and testament here by Ratifying this as my last will, an testament in whereof I have set my hand and seal this twenty third day of July 1786
