 will and testament that is to say principally and first of
 all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty
 God that gave it and my body into the earth to be buried in decent
 Christian manner and upon condition of my son-in-law William
 Davis paying all my debts that I am owing I give and bequeath
 unto my daughter Dinah Davis one negro woman named
 Jimima to her and her heirs forever - and if the said Wm.
 Davis shall refuse to pay all my debts to my request that
 the negro woman Jimima be sold at public sale six months
 credit and the money to pay all my debts that I am owing and the
 balance of the money is for my daughter Dinah Davis also one bed
 an wearing cloak and one skirt I give & bequeath unto my grand
 son Solomon Carter one bed and furniture 2 three chairs one
 woolen coat and one kerchief to him and his heirs forever, I give
 and bequeath unto my grand son Frank Allen daughter Mary
 Allen one bedstead two blankets two sheets one linen table
 one puter dish and one large pewter basin to her and her heirs forever.
 I give & bequeath unto Frank Allen son Jesse Randolph Allen the first
 choice of cows & calves not of my stock also a young steer yearling one
 table one skillet and six section plates, to him and his heirs forever
 I give & bequeath unto Hannah Paul fifteen dollars in money to her
 and her heirs forever. I give & bequeath to Ezra Paul five shillings to
 him & his heirs forever. I give & bequeath unto Sallie Paul one
 kerchief to her and her heirs forever forever. Also I give to George Paul
 one kerchief to her and her heirs forever. I give and bequeath unto my
 son Thos Carter five shillings to her & his heirs forever. I give to Rebecca
 Paul five shillings to him & his heirs forever. I give & bequeath unto
 Sallie Paul three chairs and its my wish and desire for Sallie Paul
 Hannah Paul and Rebecca Paul to have my clothes equally divided
 between them. Then also its my wish and desire that all the balance
 of my property shall be sold at six months credit and the
 money be equally divided between Solomon Carter and
 Frederick Allen and his heirs forever. Also I constitute and

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appoint my son in law Wm Davis and Frederick Allen Executors of this
 my last will and testament and I do here by utterly disallow and
 disannul all and every other last will and testament bequeath
 Executors by me in any wise before named relapsing & confirming
 this and no other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 8th day of February in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen
 Signed Sealed and acknowledged by the s^d E. Davis as her last
 will and testament in presence of us.

 of the State of North Carolina and County of Hyde being in perfect
 health of body and of perfect mind and memory thanks
 be given unto God calling to mind the mortality of
 my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men
 once to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament
 that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend
 my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my
 body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian
 burial at the discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at
 the general resurrection I shall revive in the same by the
 mighty power of God and as touching such worldly estate
 which I have in this world I have placed & committed by God to bless me with
 in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in the
 following manner and form. I give & bequeath
 unto my daughter Polly and her heirs and her heirs forever -

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and one half of the land whereon she and her husband Ebenezer Butch now live I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah one feather bed and furniture and the other half of the land where Ebenezer Butch now lives I give and bequeath unto my daughter Anna one feather bed and furniture and seven and five acres of land lying on the head of Willow Creek I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mahala one feather bed and furniture & one half of the land where I now live I give and bequeath unto my daughter Betsey one feather bed and furniture & half of the land I now live on I give to my daughter Rebecca one shilling I give unto my son Benjamin one shilling I give my wife one bed and furniture & after my death & legacies are paid my will is that the remainder of my property shall be divided between my six daughters Polly, Sarah, Malinda, Mahala, Ann, Betsey & Rebecca I appoint Jos. Harris and Ebenezer Butch Exrs of this my last will & testament. I do disavow all former wills, legacies &c. by me made ratifying and confirming this and nothing to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day & year above written. Signed sealed, published, pronounced and declared by the said James Wall as his last will and testament in presence of us who in his presence subscribed our names;

In the name of God Amen, I Nathaniel Hyde County of Spencer one of the State and County of said being before of bodily and sound mind & disposing memory do make and ordain this my last will & testament in manner and form as follows Viz^d 1st I give and bequeath unto my son William Spencer that part of my land lying to the east of a Ditch leading into Messisquit Creek to the west end of the bridge running southwesterly to Christopher Spencer line with said 3rd I give unto my son Nathan Spencer all my land to the west of the above said ditch described in the first Legacy to the Indian Line. 3rd I give unto my daughter Jenny Spencer one bed and furniture one cow and calf one wheel and one pot. 4th I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Spencer one bed and furniture one cow and calf one wheel and one pot. 5th I give unto my daughter the Morning Spencer one bed & furniture & one cow & calf one wheel and one pot. 6th I give unto my daughter Marguerite & Mary one negro woman named Lucy 7th I give unto my daughter Ruth and Jenny one negro woman named Sarah 8th I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Spencer one negro girl named Mahaly. 9th I give unto my daughter Morning Spencer one negro girl named Judith. 10th I give unto my four sons William, Nathan, Richard and Benjamin one negro boy named Sam to work with them year about until they come off to a Division by sale but not to be sold out of the family. 11th I give unto my daughter Sarah Harris one Hundred Dollars to be raised out of my property not all ready given a way after the Death of my wife. 12th It is my desire that all the Rest of my property not all ready disposed of should after the Death of my wife should be equally divided between my children when and where a like 13th It is my desire that the Legacies Third fourth and fifth should be given to my daughters by my Executors immediately after my Death. 14th That Nathaniel I have unto my beloved wife all my property Real and personally heretofore The fore Legacies Third fourth and fifth during her natural Life Then Dispose of by my Executors as directed before in this instrument. I do hereby now make and appoint my sons William and Nathaniel Spencer my Executors of this my

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
