mind & memory do make, ordain, declare and publish in
writing this my last will and testament in manner &
form following. — I Give unto my son David
Mandevell two hundred acres of Land sit- being the
plantation where on I live to him & his heirs forever — —
I Give unto my son John Mandevell one hundred &
thirty five acres of Land to him and his heirs forever —
I Give unto my son Samuel Mandevell one hundred
& fifteen acres of Land to him & his heirs forever —
I Give unto my Dear beloved wife Elizabeth Mandevell
and my two Daughters Mary Mandevell & Elizabeth Mandevell
all the Rest of my estate to be Equally Divided amongst them —
Lastly I do hereby make and ordain my son Samuel
Mandevell & David Mandevell Executors to this my last
Will & testament revoking all other wills by me made In
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
my seal this 20th April 1798. —

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State of North Carolina } Know all men by these presents that I Jesse
Hyde County } Allen of the County and State aforesaid
Being sick and weak in body but in perfect mind and memory
do make and ordain this my last will and testament — —
First I Give to my two sons Thomas Allen & Billy Allen one acre of
Land situated on a good shell coast including the manor plantation
whereon James Warren now lives which part is to be set to my
Eldest son Thomas and the other part to my son Billy but a
mower for my wife Sally Allen during her widowhood
Secondly I Give to my wife Sally Allen one partridge & furniture
two Cows & Calves two Sows & pigs together with all her poultry
Thirdly all my late Acres lying between Blacks Creek and
the main Road together with all my other Estings left to be sold
only Reserving two acres which I Give to John Alderson Esq.
provided that the said Alderson had share out a patch of
the same. — As to the Rest of my movable property both within
door and without I have to be sold & Equally divided among
all my Children namely Thomas, Sidney, Susanah, Betsy,
Billy and Henry — also my wife & divided of the Divisible
property to be paid over to her her only five penced acre and
above her Legacy — — —
I Cancelled and annul & appoint my friend E. Bell Executor
to this my last will together with my son Thomas Allen.
