furniture one cow & calf to her during her life. Eighty five
pence to my wife Jemsha Row one Black walnut table also one
linen & wooden wheel During her natural life my will
and desire is that all the perishable property that I have
before given away to my wife Jemsha Row by Legacy
after her Death to be equally divided amongst all my
Children namely John Jasper Row Enfamey Row & Santhey
Brothmator Row to them and their heirs forever —
I give to my son John Jasper Row 25 acres of Land it being
the Land fell to me by will of William Richard Inperior
also two negro boys by the name of Adam & Jacob one
Run Case & bottles one pair of Silver knee buckles all
my wearing apparel to him & his heirs forever —
I give to my daughter Enfamey two negro one boy & girl
by the name of Chancery & Reily to her and her heirs forever
also half a dozen silver table spoons one pair sugar
tongs to her & her heirs forever
all the property that I have not already given away both within
Door and without to be sold to pay my Just Debt and the
Balance if any to be equally divided amongst my three children
namely John Jasper Row Enfamey & Santhey Brothmator Row to
them & their heirs forever I Cannot take ordain and appoint
Jemsha Row Enfamey & my Brother Santhey Row executor to this
my last will and testament acknowledging this & in witness where
my Last will and testament the witnesses whereof I have here
unto set my hand and seal this twenty ninth Day of July
Eighteen hundred & two In presence of
Jesse Allen Edward B. Row Seal

& State of North Carolina being very weak and low but of
sound disposing mind & memory Thanks be to God for it
calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing
that it is appointed for all men to die I do make and ordain
Constitute & appoint this my last will and testament
in manner & form following —
I give and bequeath unto my son Hosea Cleaves all my
Land and Plantation in Conitot with all Buildings
and appurtenances thereto belonging unto him and
his heirs for ever, I give my son Noble Cleaves one
negro man named Charles to him & his heirs forever
Likewise one negro girl named Rosa which I wish to
I give my daughter Mary Davis a certain Parcel of Land
Containing one hundred acres more or less by Estimation
Beginning at the Corner of Tison middle Pasture the lower
warded Fork the creek running westerly to a post at Fork
Creek then down the creek to Tison line including an Entry
of Twenty eight acres with Tison line to my south
Corner then to the beginning of give and bequeath to my
daughter Mary Davis the above mentioned Land & then
unto her heirs forever I give & Bequeath unto my daughter
Mary Davis one negro woman named Mellice to her & her heirs forever
I then give and bequeath unto my son James Cleaves all the Remainder
Part of my Land that is not already given away belonging
to my Fork the creek Land to him & his heirs forever, I give
and bequeath unto my son James Cleaves one negro boy
named Harry to him and his heirs forever Likewise one
negro boy named Billy to him and his heirs forever
After paying all my Just Debt all the rest of my Estate I
Leave to be Equally divided Between my three children
Hosea Cleaves & Mary Davis and James Cleaves
I then Lawfully Constitute and appoint my son Hosea Cleaves
Executor to this my Last will & Testament
October 7th 1802 I have by set my hand & seal in

 memory blessed be to God this Eighteenth Day of December in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & two made and
 published this my last will and testament in manner
 following that is to say First I Give and Bequeath unto my Bro-
 ther Jonathan Harris all my land on the north side of
 David Harris Deed to him and his heirs for ever -
 I also Give unto him all my movable property on hand and
 on board. I also Give and bequeath unto my brother Josiah Harris
 all the rest of my land from David Harris Deed up to the
 said Josiah Harris line to him and his heirs forever
 I also Give and bequeath unto my father Josiah Harris my Cause
 & all six head of Hogs & six head of fowls with all my other property
 in & about Court with the warrant to the amount of six Dollars
 against John Bond &c. I also Give and Bequeath unto my two
 Sisters Legues & Pincille Harris one half of my Land lying
 toward Jennifer bay the other part adjoining Josiah Harris &
 Joseph Harris line to be Equally divided to them & their heirs forever
 I also Give and bequeath unto my brother Jesse Harris all the rest of my
 land lying on and adjoining Jennifer bay to him & his heirs forever
 I also Give unto Polly Springer fifteen allan
 Dollars to pay James Credit -
 And I also hereby make and ordain my Brother Jonathan Harris &
 Joseph Harris Executors of this my last will & testament. In witness
 whereof I the said Josiah Harris have to this my last will and
 testament set my hand & seal this the day & year above written
 Signed Sealed published and Delivered by the said Josiah
 Harris the testator as his last will & testament in the presence of
 us who were present at the time of signing and Sealing
 thereof.
