Now I give and bequeath to my daughter Ann Eliza one silver dollar in full of my estate, also I lend unto my daughter Ann Eliza two negroes Jim and Mallac during her natural life this to be equally divided between said Ann's three children but to them and their heirs forever

Stone & fire and begin with my own John Elome one negro man called
Ben and also one negro called Sam a former Wippa slave and
also four hundred and fifty acres of land lying in Braintree
County in the fork of town Creek known by the name of Sandy
Piters built to him and his heirs for ever —

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Item 100 and bequeath to my Daughter Margaret Eborn two negroes
called Little Tom and Live one bed and furniture and Cane and
Bells and to her and The heirs last will. Be it remembered

negroes called Union, Hammer and Sam, and one bad and
