and State of North Carolina being in sound mind and in
my proper senses have thought fit to dispose of my worldly
good in manner & form following

I have I send unto my wife Ann Easter my land and plantation
whereon I now live during her natural life also my negro
woman Phillis and negro girl by name of Frances to hold
during her natural life also I send unto my wife Ann Easter
all my stock of every kind whatsoever and all my house-
hold furniture & kitchen furniture of every kind
whatsoever in consideration of which she is to give all my
children sufficient schooling

Item I give unto my daughter Priscy Easter & Epimacy Easter
after the Death of her mother my negro woman Phillis & my
negro girl by name of Frances to be Equally Divided Between
them share & share alike to them & their heirs forever

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son William Easter the land
& plantation whereon I now live after the Death of my wife to
hold in fee simple to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and Bequeath unto my daughter Sally Easter two
Cows & Land and one Bed & furniture which to be accepted
in the part of my stock & furniture to my wife also I give
my daughter Sally Easter two Cows & Calves out of the stock
before mentioned in love to my wife which she is to have
before my wife has my stock in love

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son William Easter one
Bed & furniture two Cows & Calves two Ewes & Land & me give

It is my will and Desire that all my stock of every kind
& household & kitchen furniture that I have sent my wife
be Equally Divided at her Death between my two daughters
Epimacy Easter & Priscy Easter and Lastly I do ordain
this to be my last will & testament Revoking all other prior
to this made by me aforesaid and appoint my
beloved wife & Jacob Looley Junior to be my executor to
this my will, In witness whereof I set my hand & seal this the
16th November 1802

In the Name of God Amen, I Roger Barrow of the County of Hyde
& State of North Carolina now being in a low state of health but
sound in mind have thought fit to make and ordain this my
last will and testament in writing

I send unto my beloved mother all my land and
tenances which I am now in possession of during her
natural life or widowhood I also send unto her all my
stock & furniture of every kind and all my negroes
during her natural life or widowhood

Item I give devise and bequeath unto Roger Boyl fifty acres
of land more or less lying in Beaufort County of North
Carolina after the Death or marriage of my mother provided that he
should die without an heir then I give the same piece of land
unto Zacharias Boyl to him & his heirs forever

Item I give devise & bequeath unto Charles Barrow Tooley all my
land in Hyde County after the Death or marriage of my
mother provided that the said Charles Barrow Tooley should die
without an heir then I give unto Benjamin Jarrett the son of
Benjamin Jarrett provided that the said Benjamin Jarrett
should die without an heir then I give devise and bequeath

it unto William Boyl to him & his heirs forever
Item I give unto William Boyl one negro man by name
of Dick after the Death or marriage of my mother unto
him & his heirs — Item I give unto Eunice & Laro
Barrow one negro man by the name of Samick
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
