 of mine. I give unto my beloved wife Dorcas Rascoe two beds  
 & furniture. I give unto my daughter Elizabeth furniture. What  
 I give unto my daughter Mary Three Dollars for the purpose of  
 buying her a wheel. I give unto my daughter one bed & pillow  
 in Revolution, all the Rest of my Cattle unto my wife Dorcas Rascoe  
 all the Rest of my property I require to be Equally divided between  
 my wife and four Children namely, Elizabeth, David and Mary  
 Rascoe, it is my will and desire that my son David Rascoe  
 should take care and give my wife Dorcas Rascoe a good  
 education during her natural life and then to have that  
 part of my property that I have bequeathed unto her &c &c.  
 Lastly and all Provisionals and appoint my trusty friend  
 William Harris Executor to this my Last will & Testament first  
 proving and making void all other wills heretofore made by  
 me or for me in testimony whereof I have set my hand  
 and seal this Third Day of June 1806

 body but of sound disposing mind and memory thank debt at-  
 tributed to God, and knowing the mortality of man and that it is ap-  
 pointed for all men once to die, desire to make this my Last will  
 and Testament in manner and form following first and prin-  
 cipally I Recommend my soul into the hands of allmighty God who  
 take it me and my body to be Buried at the Discretion of my friends  
 hereafter mentioned. — Then I give and bequeath unto my well  
 beloved sun Ephraim Elms all my property or Estate that I now  
 possess except one Cow belonging to my mother Mary Ford, and one  
 half to my sister Eliza Coffey & the other first share of the same  
 I nominate Executor and appoint my trusty friend the said  
 William Harris Executor of this my Last will & Testament Revoking all  
 other wills or wills heretofore made allowing this only to be my  
 Last will and Testament in testimony whereof I have set my hand  
 and seal this 10<sup>th</sup> Day of March A.D. 1804 —
