ro girl named Nisiah to her and her heirs for ever

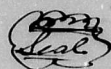
I give my daughter Winford Winfield thirty pounds

shall hereafter mention. I also give and bequeath
to my daughter Rebecca Rogers five shillings current
money of this state to be paid to her by my Executors
after my death out of my personal property

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Rogers three
orphan children ten pounds a piece current money of this
state to be paid to them when they come of age as I shall
hereafter mention. Item I and my negro woman
named Cate to my beloved wife during her life and
afterwards I give her to my son Jesse Davis. I also give
to my son Jesse my negro woman named Judith
and my negro girl named Selena to him and his heirs
forever on condition that he shall pay to my daughter
Winford Winfield thirty pounds current money of this
state and ten pounds a piece of my daughter Rebecca
Rogers three orphan children current money of this state
as I have given unto them. I give unto my four sons
all my Carpenter & Joiner Tools to be Equally Divided

Item It is my will and pleasure that my beloved wife Elizabeth
Davis & my two sons Jesse & Richard Davis and my daughter
Lydia should have all the remainder of my personal
property that is not already given away to be Equally
Divided amongst them.

And I hereby make and ordain my three beloved sons John
William & Jesse Davis Executors of this my last will & Testa-
ment in witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal the Day and Date above written

State of North Carolina I John Ethridge of the County
Hyde County and State aforesaid do make &
ordain this to be my last will and Testament. To wit,

Item I and with my Beloved Mother Lydia leave my Plantation
and land and my negro man Adam during her natural
Life together with all the Rest of my property wholly & solely
and after her Decease I give this said land and negro Adam
and all the rest of my Estate to be Equally Divided Betwixt my
two Sister Susanah Jasper and Dinah Ethridge to them and
their heirs for ever to have and to hold the same in good Right
title and principle - and I do appoint and ordain my beloved
Mother Lydia leave Executor to this my last will & Testament
in witness whereof I set my hand & seal this 20th January 1803
