In the name of God Amen, John Gaylord of the County of Hyde & State of North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and memory do hereby give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Louisa Gaylord and her named heirs with a Rattle and bridle, I send to my said wife during her Life or widowhood all further land & premises and after her Death or widowhood I desire the above said land to be divided above & about all the between my Children named Sophia, Elizabeth, Dorcas, Henry, Miley, Harriet, John, George, William & Jeremiah Gaylord, I send to my wife two negro women during her Life or widowhood or until shea & her heirs and their increase, and after her Death or marriage, I desire them and their increase to be Equally divided amongst the above named Children, I give to my beloved wife two Doves & pigs with eight three year old hounds & spirit some, also six ewe & lambs I send to my wife during her Life or widowhood all my cattle & their increase and after her death or marriage, I desire them and their increase to be Equally divided amongst all my above named Children I will that all my Land and House on broad brick and swamps be Equally divided amongst all the above named Children this is to say the full when married and the boys when they come to the years of majority or twenty one years of age on their heirs, I will from the said acres of Land in and about the Rattle ground pasture by John Allen also ninety nine acres of Land formerly owned by John Elmore adjoining said Land to be Equally divided amongst the above named Children and their heirs as above mentioned also my will is that all the above Land and with mentioned above when divided amongst the above named Children to be Equally divided amongst them according to the Value, my will is that my Executors & Assigns do not sell or alienate and hire out by public auction as they should think proper for the advantage of the said estate the above mentioned with and lands carrying a privilege for my wife during her Life or widowhood the buildings and plantations can live and an out of the year

where on Iron Line my will is that my Executors & Executors
do advertise and sell at six months credit all my household
& Kitchen furniture & what I have not given away Rem-
aining out of the said furniture as my wife should
during her life & widowhood my will is that my Executors
& Executors live and yearly my negro man Adah and the
sixth part of a mare named Leticia, also to keep for the
benefit of the above named children after paying my
Last full Debt, my will is that my Executors & Executors shall
at six months credit sell all the residue of my boys & daughters
word & servants & barnyard & their except a Double Chair to be
given to my beloved wife my will is that my Executors &
Executors sell four hundred & eighty acres of Land more or
less lying on the south side of Pamlico river whereon Richard
Jasper now lives at such to suit as they shall think proper for
the Benefit of the above named children, also all my Land
within quarter Run bay and millstream &c. my will is
that my Executors & Executors do sell the said Land at such
time and place as they shall think proper for the benefit
of the above mentioned children also my will is that my
Executors & Executors sell also my Lot in Gunpowder
and my wife and title in the Land of Christopher
Massey lived on and conveyed by said Massey to Martin
Phelps, all the Remainder of my Estate within and without
Dove that is not already given away to be sold at six
months credit by my Executors & Executors, my will is that my
Executors and Executors pay all my Just Debt out of the said
