I John Hall of the County of Aske & Province of North Carolina
Being weak in Body but in perfect mind and memory do make
and ordain this my last Will and Testament in form following
that is to say Give and Recomend my soul into hands of Almighty
God that gave it & my Body I Recommend to Earth to be decently
interred at the Discretion of my Executing & touching Worlthy Estate which
it hath pleased God to Bless me with, I Will & Bequeath in the
following manner & form.

I give & Bequeath to my son James Hall one Cow & Calf & one Ewe Lamb
to him & his heirs, - Item, I give & Bequeath to my son John Hall
one cow and calf & one Ewe Lamb & one Lamb & his Heirs.

Item I give & Bequeath to my son Thomas Hall one cow & calf & one Ewe and
Lamb to him and his heirs, Item I give and Bequeath to my son
William Hall one cow & calf & one Ewe Lamb to him and his Heirs.

Item I give & Bequeath to my son Benjamin Hall One cow & calf & one Ewe Lamb to
him & his heirs, - Item I give and Bequeath to my daughter Anna Hall &
one brother Bed & Furniture two cows & calves one Ewe Lamb to her & her
Heirs, and after my debts & charges are paid. My will and desire is that my
will & Beloved wife Mary Hall may have the use and property of the Remander
of my Estate during her Natural Life and other Estates to equally
Divided among all my children. Further I do make & ordain my
Loving Wife Mary Hall my truly tried & tried friend to my whole &
sole Executor to this my last Will & Testament In witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and Seal. This 13 day of June 1776
